# CNY payments to China

When submitting a payment order in CNY (Chinese yuan) to China, some specific information should be provided in order to fulfil the local regulation. Should the transaction miss the information specified below, it might be delayed in processing or cancelled and not sent towards the beneficiary. Please contact the beneficiary in order to retrieve his/her details for the payment.

Note: This document contains sample data for this payment type for illustration – and stresses out only fields/information that are different from other cross-border payments (i.e. does not describe general transaction attributes such as amount, currency etc.).

## List of specific transaction attributes for CNY payments

- beneficiary
  - real name (individual or company) to retrieve the funds
  - the first line with the address should start with the ADD abbreviation
- reason or purpose of the transaction
  - dependent on the transaction's nature, one of the code words should be provided:

CGODDR - for goods related payments

CSTRDR - for services related payments

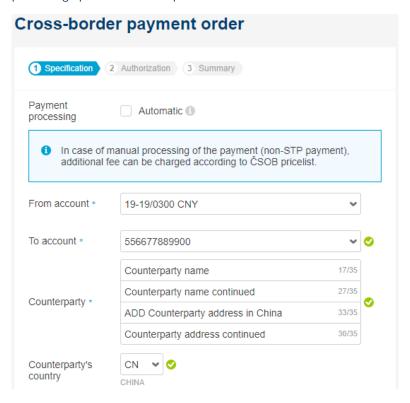

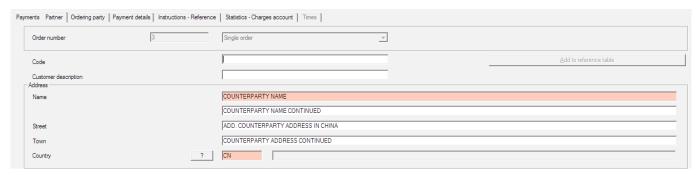
